CSEA/SCÉA Dissertation Award

The Award:

The winner of the CSEA/SCÉA Dissertation Award will receive a certificate and \$500, and will be invited to present their work at the CSEA/SCÉA national conference. The winner will also be invited to submit their work to be considered for publication in the *Canadian Review of Art Education / Revue canadienne d'éducation artistique*.

Annual Timeline:

Submissions must be received by the CSEA/SCÉA Secretary General on or before **Sept. 30**. Submissions will be forwarded to a panel of three experienced researchers in art education at Canadian universities. The recipient will be notified by **Dec. 15** and the award will be conferred at the national conference.

Criteria:

The recipient of this award will have successfully defended their doctoral dissertation in art education at a Canadian university within two calendar years preceding the application deadline. The review panel will be seeking an outstanding dissertation that is:

- original;
- employs a high degree of creativity and/or critique;
- demonstrates a sophisticated engagement with both theoretical and practical considerations;
- deals with contemporary matters of interest to art education in Canada.

Please submit the following:

- This completed application / nomination form;
- A summary of no more than 2,000 words (including footnotes, but separate from reference list), which includes the full title and a summary written to the following subheadings:
 - (i) Research questions;
 - (ii) A brief review of major literature;
 - (iii) Methodology;
 - (iv) Major conclusions;
 - (v) Statement of significance for the field of art education in Canada.
- Reference List

PLEASE NOTE: The review panel will consider the summary and reference list using a blind review process. Please remove all identification of applicant / supervisor / institution from these documents.

Short listed finalists may be asked to submit a full electronic version of their dissertation, including a copy of the signed and dated committee acceptance.
