Canadian Art Educator of the Year Award (Grades 9 to 12)

The Award:

In addition to an Award certificate, the recipient will receive \$1,000 (cash and/or gift certificate).

Annual Timeline:

Nominations must be received by the CSEA/SCÉA Secretary on or before **Dec. 15, 2023** who will share them with the Awards Sub-Committee for review. The recipient will be notified by **Mar. 1, 2024** and the award will be conferred at the national conference.

Criteria:

Art educators teaching Grades 9 to 12 in public or independent school systems in Canada can be nominated for this award. The nominee should be a mid to late career art educator and demonstrate:

- excellence in art teaching,
 - leadership in art education,
 - a significant contribution to art education locally and beyond,
 - evidence that they are addressing inclusivity and diversity in their teaching,
 - the mandate of the CSEA/SCÉA.

- Both nominee and nominator must be current members of the CSEA/SCÉA.
 - Each nominee may be nominated for one award per awards season.
 - Each individual may only receive the same award once.

Please submit the following:

- This completed nomination form;
- A letter of support from a professional colleague;
- The nominee's Curriculum Vitae;
- One photograph of the nominee along with 2-3 photos of them at work with learners, and/or their own artwork, and/or their learners' art works. Photos should be 300 dpi jpgs.
