

CSEA/SCÉA Master's Thesis Award

The Award:

The winner of the CSEA/SCÉA Master's Thesis Award will receive a certificate and \$250, and will be invited to present their work at the CSEA/SCÉA national conference. They will also be invited to submit their work to be considered for publication in the *Canadian Review of Art Education*.

Annual Timeline:

Submissions must be received by the CSEA/SCÉA Secretary on or before **Dec. 15**, **2023**. Submissions will be forwarded to a panel of 3 experienced researchers in art education at Canadian universities. The recipient will be notified by **March 1**, **2024** and the award will be conferred at the national conference.

Criteria:

The recipient of this award will have successfully defended their Master's Thesis in Art Education at a Canadian university in 2022, 2023, or 2024. The review panel will be seeking an outstanding thesis that is:

- · original;
- · employs a high degree of creativity and/or critique;
- demonstrates a sophisticated engagement with both theoretical and practical considerations;
- deals with contemporary matters of interest to art education in Canada.
- The applicant must be a current member of the CSEA/SCÉA.
- The applicant may only apply for this award once. The same thesis cannot be submitted for consideration in future years.

Please submit the following:

- · This completed nomination form;
- A summary of no more than 2,000 words (including footnotes), which includes the full title and a summary written to the following subheadings:
 - Research questions.
 - A brief review of major literature,
 - Methodology,
 - Major conclusions,
 - Statement of significance for the field of art education in Canada;
- · Reference list.
